As you know, the election has resulted in a shift of government. We do not yet know the exact composition of the government, nor do we exactly know when it will take office. But we are already able to say how the questionnaire should be modified according to the election outcome.

- Q. 6A: Use the phrases: "I am referring to the policies of the government before this year's election" and "...was mostly due to...".
- Q. 6B: Use the phrase "Has this been mostly due to the policies of the government or mostly due to other reasons".

 (Note that the word 'or' has been left out of the text by mistake).
- Q. 7A: Use the phrase "I am referring to the government we had until this year's election".
- Q. 9A: Use the phrase "the government we had until the election".
- Q. 10A: Use the phrase "the government we had until the election".
- Q. 14: The question shall be asked.

 Before the day the non-socialist government takes office, use the phrase "As you know, we will get...".

 After the day the non-socialist government has taken office, use the phrase "As you know, we have got...".

Before the interview, go through the questionnaire and delete the phrases not to be used. No other changes in the questionnaire are necessary. You can start interviewing immediately.
